## **Pfizer Program Makes Prescription Medicine Available to Unemployed Workers**

Pfizer Pharmaceutical has informed the State Building Trades Council of a program by which it is making free prescription medicines available to unemployed workers who were previously taking a Pfizer medicine but who have lost their health coverage.

Individuals may be eligible if they have been unemployed for at least three months, and were prescribed and had been taking a Pfizer medicine for three months prior to becoming unemployed, currently have no prescription coverage, and can attest to financial hardship.
